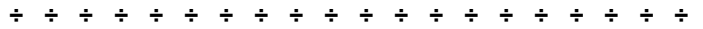
Lord Jesus, the 'door' of our salvation, whom the Church is charged to proclaim always, everywhere and to all as 'our hope.'"

The Renewal of Our Minds and Hearts in Christ (cont. from previous bulletin) This hope and trust in Jesus can only be strengthened and sustained when we personally encounter Him and allow our minds and hearts to be renewed by His truth and grace. "Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good, acceptable, and perfect." (Rom 12:2)

Only Jesus fully reveals the merciful love of God and also reveals the truth about the human person, which gives meaning to our lives. "The truth is that only in the mystery of the incarnate word does the mystery of man take on light." (Vatican II, Gaudium et Spes) The current crisis in both the world and even in some places in the Church is that we have lost our story, the story of god's loving plan of salvation. Strengthening our hope in Christ in order to share that hope with others involves re-acquiring a biblical worldview through prayerful reading and study of sacred Scripture, ongoing catechesis and formation, and education in the witness and wisdom of the saints who have gone before us in heroically living the Catholic faith. This conversion of mind and heart will help us to see, think, and act like Jesus and to be His disciples and witnesses in the world. (diocs.org)
