"According to the Popes of the last 100 years, there is no devotion more important to the life of the Church than devotion to the Heart of Jesus," theologian Dr. Robert Stackpole tells us. But why?

Embrace the Sacred Heart

Our Lord also asked St. Margaret Mary for the establishment of a feast in honor of His Sacred Heart. That was accomplished by Blessed Pius IX in 1856. We still celebrate this feast 19 days after Pentecost.

So let's take stock: the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, the First Fridays, and veneration of the Sacred Heart Image. Dr. Stackpole tells us, "By these means, our Lord intended to rekindle the fire of love in the hearts of the faithful in a modern world in which the hearts of many were growing cold."

Let us embrace this devotion and share it with our family, friends, and neighbors. Let us love the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Heart that loves us all so well.
